Dr. Jacob Frenkel is Chairman & CEO of the Washington based economics organisation, the Group of Thirty (G-30) which is a private, nonprofits', Consultative Group on International Economic and Monetary Affairs. In 2007, he joined the advisory board of an Israel based biotech firm BrainStorm Cell Therapeutic, Inc. and is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Institute for International Economics (IIE).

Dr Frenkel studied economics and political science at the University of Jerusalem and gained an M.A. and doctorate in economics at the University of Chicago. From 2000 to 2004 he was Chairman of Merrill Lynch International. Between 1991 and 2000 he served two terms as Governor of the Bank of Israel. From 1987 to 1991, he was economic counsellor and director of research at the International Monetary Fund, and from 1973 to 1987 he was on the faculty of the University of Chicago where he served as the David Rockefeller Professor of International Economics. He is the recipient of honorary degrees and awards from various universities and governments.
