Mr Juncker was Luxembourg's Minister for Finances from 1989 to 2009, was appointed Prime Minister in 1995 and then re-elected in 1999. The second term he coincided with significant changes in Europe's political and economic constitution. He stood out as one of the key players in the creation of the Maastricht Treaty, in particular of the volume concerning the Economic and Monetary Union of which he wrote large sections himself. Jean-Claude Juncker has also been Governor of the World Bank, Governor of the International Monetary Fund and Governor of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development.
